100% Residence Homestead Exemption for 100% Disabled Veterans

A disabled veteran who receives 100 percent disability compensation for a service-connected disability **and** has either a 100 percent disability rating or a determination of individual unemployability from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs is entitled to a full exemption from taxation on the total appraised value of the veteran's residence homestead.

The surviving spouse of a veteran who qualified for this exemption, or who would have qualified for it had the exemption been available at the time of the veteran's death, may also receive the exemption, subject to certain statutory restrictions.

An application for a residence homestead exemption must be filed in order to receive this benefit.

Partial Exemption for Disabled Veterans

Texas law provides partial property tax exemptions for veterans with service-connected disabilities, as well as for the surviving spouses and surviving children of deceased disabled veterans. These exemptions also apply to homesteads donated to disabled veterans by charitable organizations, either at no cost or for no more than 50 percent of the property's good-faith market value. The exemption amount is based on the veteran's percentage of service-connected disability.

DISABILITY RATING	EXEMPTION AMOUNT
10% - 29%	\$5,000
30% - 49%	\$7,500
50% - 69%	\$10,000
70% - 100%	\$12,000
